 - Reinforcement, Preference Assessments and techniques to increase behavior

 - Behavioral Parent Training
 - Assessment and evaluation, including the use of the Assessment of Basic Language and Learning Skills - Revised (ABLLS-R)
 - Functional Behavioral Assessment
 - Behavior Management and Behavior Support Plans
