

Description

More learners with autism spectrum disorders are included in regular educational environments every year. For successful integration, strategic supports must be provided to learners in these settings. This workshop will review the unique needs of learners with autism spectrum disorders, and will highlight how specific strategies can increase their success in classrooms. Attention will be given to addressing challenging behaviors, as well as to increasing independence and socialization.

Mary Jane Weiss, Ph.D., BCBA, is an Associate Research Professor at the Graduate School of Applied and Professional Psychology at Rutgers University. She is Clinical Director of the Douglass School at the Douglass Developmental Disabilities Center. Her interests center around identifying best practice ABA services for individuals with autism, and she has presented at local, national, and international conferences regarding these issues. Additionally, she has published extensively in the field of Applied Behavior Analysis including articles and books.
